Description of the tour:

Departure on the coach from Valencia Conference Centre at 18h30 to Downtown. We will arrive to the **Serrano Towers**, where we will start the walking visit of the Historical Centre of Valencia.



Serrano Towers are the main witnesses of the medieval walls, now disappeared. We will continue to the **Square of the Virgin**. We will discover the stories of its main buildings: the **Basilica of our Lady of the Forsaken** and the **Turia's Fountain**.

In this square we celebrate two important valencian traditions: the **Floral Tribute to our Lady of the Forsaken** and the meetings of the **Water Tribunal**. We will continue to tour of this square observing the Renaissance Architecture of the **Palace of the Generalitat**, head office of your Regional Government.

Then we will walk by the **Miguelete**, the popular bell tower the the **Cathedral**. We will explain some tales and anecdotes of the Cathedral before continuing the tour to the **Silk Exchange** building a gorgeous building of the XV Century, when Valencia had an important commercial relevance in the Mediterranean Area.



Then we will “jump” to 1914. We will just have to cross the Street to find the **Central Market of Valencia**. We will discover through this awesome market the Valencian Modernism, back in the early XX Century.

We will finish our tour at the famous **Round Square**. End of the tour.
